## Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

June 27, 2021

Wis 1:13-15; 2 Cor 8:7, 9, 13-15; Mk 5:21-43  
Psalm 30

Dear Families:

After thirty years of mortal life, God, made man, remained in the Eucharist, so that men of all times and places could eat His flesh and drink His blood. The religious aspirations of humanity have been more than fulfilled. Man could never have dreamt of, much less achieved by his own efforts, such an approach, and such intimate contact with God.

The passage of today's Gospel is a revelation of this. The woman of faith, who was sick, heard of Jesus, and thought she would be cured just by touch, and so it happened. St. Mark describes this episode in full detail. The essential thing is to reach out to Jesus, in faith, and hear his words: "Daughter, your faith has saved you. Go in peace and be cured of your affliction". (Mark 5:27-34)

There are many ways to reach out and touch Jesus. Routine is not the best of ways. Rather, reaching out to touch Him with humility, conscience and faith will lead to us feeling His presence in close proximity, giving us peace and comfort, as he speaks to us through scripture.

Today's Gospel also tells us about the story of the resurrection of Jairus' daughter. The friends of Jairus believed that Jesus only had power to cure diseases in the living. So they sent Jairus a message, "Your daughter has died; why trouble the teacher any longer?" (Mark 5:35). When they arrived at the house of Jairus, Jesus told those present: "The child is not dead but asleep". (Mark 5:39)

Death is a reality, but the Lord wants believers to not consider it the end. "Because life, for those who believe in Christ, does not end, but rather is transformed; and as our earthly dwelling ends, we gain an everlasting mansion in heaven". (Preface of the Mass for the Dead)

Finally, Jesus raised the girl. And he told her parents to give her some food.

He said the same to us, for we will, on the last day, rise again and join Him in eternal life: "I am the bread of life ... whoever eats this bread will live forever". (Jn 6:48-54)

Today, therefore, we have this message: not of death, but of life; not of condemnation, but of hope. May Jesus grant us the faith that brings us closer to Him every day, and may we feel His saving presence in our lives.

## Decimotercer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

27 de junio del 2021

Sab 1:13-15; 2:23-24; 2 Cor 8:7, 9, 13-15; Mc 5:21-43  
Salmo 30 [29]

Queridas familias:

Después de treinta años de vida mortal, Dios, hecho hombre, se quedó en la Eucaristía, para que los hombres de todos los tiempos y latitudes pudiéramos comer su carne y beber su sangre. La aspiración religiosa de la humanidad se ha cumplido con creces. Nunca los hombres pudieron soñar, ni menos alcanzar por propio esfuerzo, tal acercamiento y un contacto tan íntimo con Dios.

El pasaje del evangelio de hoy es toda una revelación de lo que acabamos de decir. La mujer de fe, que estaba enferma, oyó hablar de Jesús y pensó que con solo tocarle quedaría curada; y así pasó. Esta escena la describe San Marcos con abundancia de detalles; lo esencial es tocar con fe a Jesús y oír sus palabras: "hija, tu fe te ha curado. Vete en paz y queda curada de tu enfermedad" (Mc 5:27-34).

Hay muchas maneras de acercarse y tocar a Jesús; la rutina no es la mejor, sino la humildad y conciencia de querer tocarle con fe y sentir su presencia a nuestro lado hablándonos, dándonos paz y consuelo.

Tenemos también en este evangelio de hoy el relato de la resurrección de la hija de Jairo. Los amigos de Jairo pensaban que Jesús sólo tenía poder para curar enfermedades. Por eso le mandan a decir: "Tu hija ha muerto. ¿A qué molestar al maestro?" (Mc 5:35). Llegados a la casa de Jairo, Jesús dijo a los presentes: "La niña no está muerta, está dormida" (Mc 5:39).

La muerte es una realidad, pero el Señor quiere que los creyentes no la consideren como si fuera el fin. "Porque la vida de los que creemos en Cristo, no termina, se transforma; y, al deshacerse nuestra morada terrenal, adquirimos una mansión eterna en el cielo". (Prefacio de la Misa de Difuntos).

Finalmente, Jesús resucitó a la muchacha. Y les dijo a sus padres que le dieran de comer.

Lo mismo nos dijo a nosotros, si queremos un día resucitar para la vida eterna: "Yo soy el pan de vida...si uno come de este pan vivirá para siempre" (Jn 6:48-54).

Hoy, por tanto, tenemos este mensaje de vida y no de muerte; de esperanza y no de condenación. Que Jesús nos conceda la fe que nos acerque a él cada día más y sentir su presencia salvadora en nuestras vidas.

### The First Martyrs of Rome

Died 64 – 68

Feast Day – June 30

After a raging fire destroyed two-thirds of Rome in 64, Emperor Nero blamed Rome’s Christians to divert suspicion from himself. Those acknowledging their Christianity were arrested and executed. Some were covered in wax and set afire as torches; some were sewn into animal skins and cast into the arena with wild animals; others were crucified. Sts. Peter and Paul died in the same persecution. The feast of these earliest martyrs of the Roman church is celebrated a day after the joint feast of Peter and Paul. The Roman historian Tacitus said the protomartyrs were to be pitied “for it was felt that they were being sacrificed to one man’s brutality.”

Luego de un fuego arrasador que destruy3 las dos terceras partes de Roma en el a3o 64, el emperador Ner3n culp3 a los cristianos romanos a fin de desviar la atenci3n de s3 mismo. Aquellos que dec3an ser cristianos fueron arrestados y ejecutados. A algunos los cubrieron con cera y les prendieron fuego como antorchas; a otros los cubrieron con pieles de animales y los echaron al ruedo con animales salvajes; otros fueron crucificados. Los santos Pedro y Pablo fallecieron durante esa misma persecuci3n. La fiesta de estos primeros m3rtires de la Iglesia Cat3lica se celebra un d3a despu3s de la fiesta de san Pedro y san Pablo. El historiador romano T3cito dijo que los protom3rtires eran dignos de l3stima “porque se sent3a que estaban siendo sacrificados por la brutalidad de un solo hombre”.

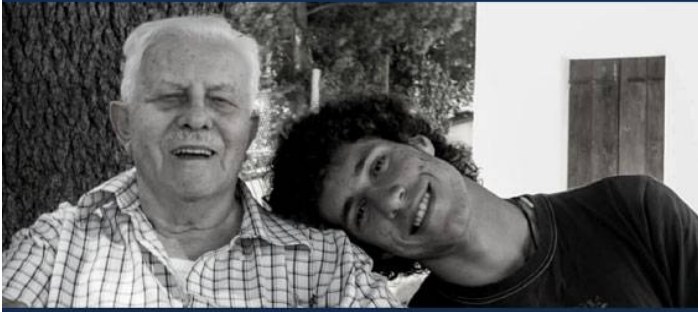
