Dear Families:

We often worry about the future and try to save a little. It is wise to do so, and shows the care we have for our family, should a problem arise, at any given time. We also save, in anticipation of education expenses for our children or grandchildren, etc. So, saving is an expression of love, if not made solely to store and keep money for more selfish reasons.

Our community is known for its generosity, in support of our Parish aid programs. I admire you for that. It is a token of love. Also, as a token of love, many brothers and sisters sacrifice to help their families, living back in their countries of origin...sending monetary aid, in order to lessen the difficulties of parents and other family members. They do this, despite the scarcity of jobs and major financial difficulties we are suffering, as a result of this ongoing economic crisis.

Today, the first reading, tells the story of a woman who had almost nothing. Their small portion of remaining food would soon run out, and then she and her son would die. Her generosity and trust in God, however, returned in abundance what she had given - the last bit of oil and flour she had to sustain her and her son.

Today's Gospel tells the story of a widow who gives in alms what little she had. Jesus praises her total generosity and her trust that God will provide.

What is our level of generosity? We must give a little of our own. God will never abandon us. I bear witness that what I am writing, I experience in my own life at every turn.

May God bless you for your generosity.

Queridas familias:

Nuestra comunidad se distingue por su generosidad para el soporte de los gastos y los programas de ayuda de nuestra Parroquia. Yo les admiro por esto. Es una muestra de amor. También es amor lo que muchos hermanos y hermanas nuestros hacen por sus familias en los países de origen: envían ayudas para que las dificultades de los padres o familiares sean menores. Lo hacen, a pesar de la escasez de puestos de trabajo y las grandes dificultades financieras que estamos sufriendo como consecuencia de esta crisis económica en curso.

Hoy, la primera lectura, cuenta la historia de una mujer que no tenía casi nada. La pequeña porción de comida que les quedaba pronto se acabaría, y luego ella y su hijo morirían. Su generosidad y confianza en Dios, sin embargo, le devuelven en abundancia lo que había dado – el último aceite y harina que le quedaban para su sustento y el de su hijo.

En el evangelio de hoy se narra la historia de una viuda que da de limosna lo poco que tenía. Jesús alaba la generosidad total y la confianza en que Dios va a proveer.

¿Cuál es nuestro nivel de generosidad? Debemos dar un poco de lo nuestro. Dios no nos abandonará nunca. Doy testimonio de que esto que les escribo lo experimento en mi propia vida a cada paso.



Celebrated November 7-13, 2021, is an annual week-long celebration of the Catholic Church in the United States dedicated to promoting vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life through prayer and education, and to renew our prayers and support for those who are considering one of these particular vocations. NVAW began in 1976 when the U. S. bishops designated the 28th Sunday of the year for NVAW. In 1997, this celebration was moved to coincide with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which falls on January 13 in 2013. Beginning in 2014, NVAW was moved to the first full week of November.

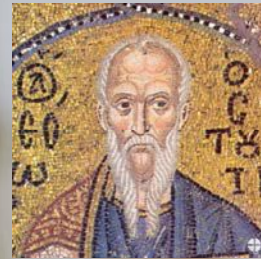

Saint of the Week



Theodore the Studite

759 – 826

Feast Day - November 11

A great figure in Christian monasticism, Theodore was born in Constantinople (Istanbul, Turkey), but began monastic life in Bithynia. He returned to Constantinople to study for the priesthood and in 787 was ordained. In 794, he succeeded his uncle, St. Pluto, as abbot of Sakkoudion, where his ideals and rules had far-reaching influence. He later moved his monks to a Constantinople monastery founded by the Roman consul Studius. Theodore was exiled several times: for opposing an emperor's divorce and adultery, and also for defending the veneration of sacred images. He supported the authority of the see of Rome, preached brilliantly, and left a trove of

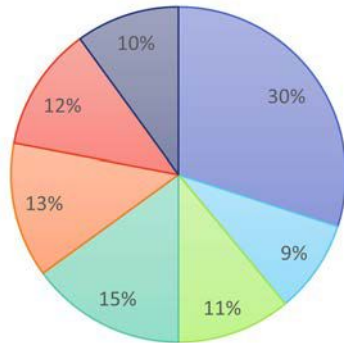
