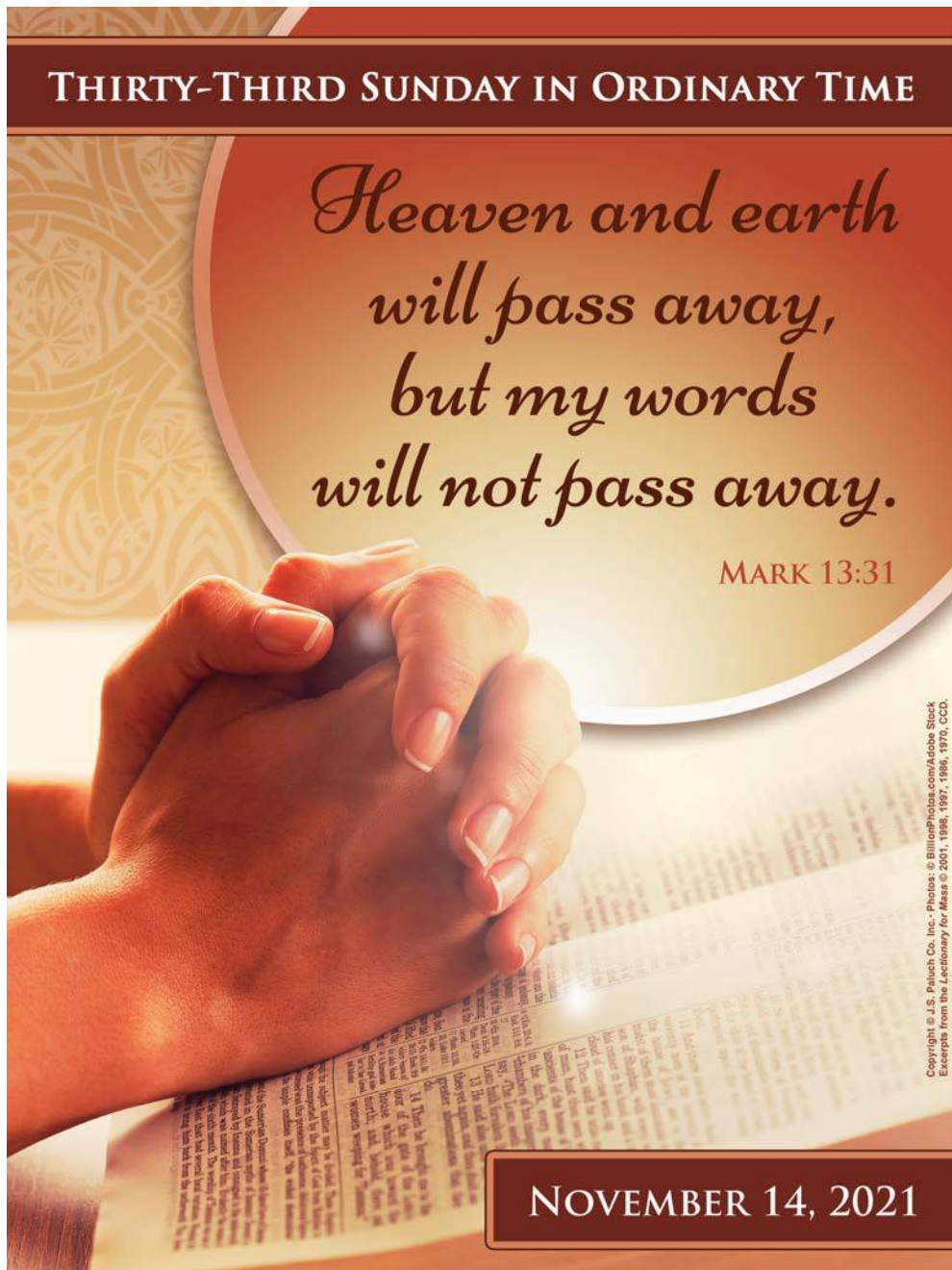

Dear Families:

When we were kids we needed to be loved, understood and cared for by others. As we grow we want to be free and independent, but at the same time, loved, respected and valued for our values and talents. But more in some of us, there is a feeling, deep in our soul, that is not completely satisfied with love, appreciation or acceptance.

The entrance of sin into the world (original sin) has left human beings in a state of dependency and insecurity because of their broken relationship with God. The solution to this human problem is in God. Only he can fill the void in our hearts.

Jesus, the Son of God, offered his life on the cross for the forgiveness of sins and the reconciliation with God, our Creator. He is our Peace. Our fears, insecurities, dependence to other's love, the need to be valued and appreciated ... all become secondary, when we feel, within us, the saving presence of God, who, through Christ, we learned to call Father.

Through Baptism we join in the death and resurrection of Christ. This truth of our faith makes us perfect, because through Him we are sanctified. There is a moment, during the Mass, that we give each other the sign of Peace. This is the Peace of Christ, which we offer each other, in reflection of what He did with his disciples, when He appeared to them after His resurrection and said: "Peace be with you".

May this word of Jesus, resonate in your hearts, especially in the midst of trouble, crisis, fears, and human insecurities. Remember that Christ is our Peace.

May God bless you with Peace.

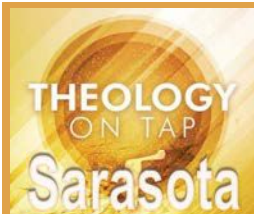

Saint of the Week



Blessed Lucy of Narni

1476 - 1544

Feast Day - November 15

Lucia Brocadelli wanted to become a nun, but when she was 15, her family arranged her marriage to a count. After three years the marriage was not consummated, and her husband freed her. As a Dominican tertiary, she joined communities in Rome and Viterbo, where she received the stigmata, which church investigations found genuine. Meanwhile, the Duke of Ferrara, who wanted a mystic for his town, built Lucy a convent in Ferrara. The move was ill-fated. Lucy endured resentment from other nuns, the death of her patron and loss of the stigmata; she was replaced as superior and spent her last 40 years in obscurity. She was beatified in 1710.
