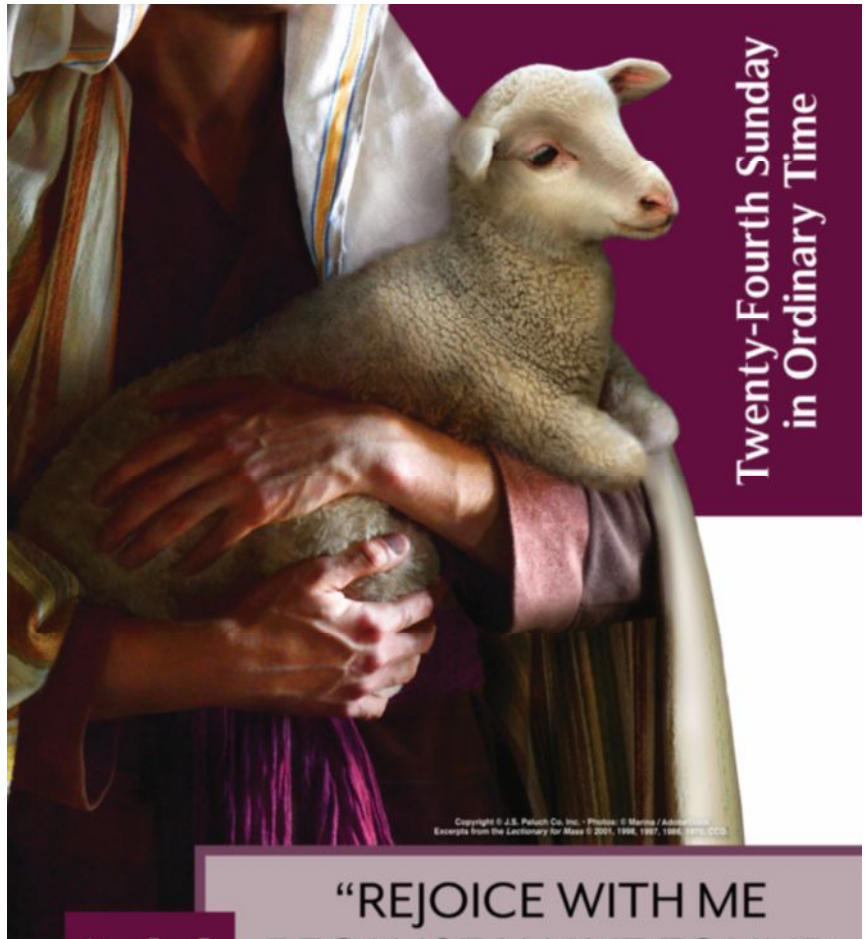

## Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

September 11, 2022

Exodus 32:7-11, 13-14; 1 Timothy 1:12-17;

Luke 15:1-32 [1-10]

Psalm 51

Dear Families:

Conversion, forgiveness, and happiness are three interrelated aspects of human life.

We have limitations. We are not almighty; we are born needing others. This is why we always try to seek independence and secure happiness and joy. However, we don't always look in the right places to achieve this. For some, the important thing is to enjoy the present, while for others, it is securing the future. In both cases, the focus of life is on material things with the belief that material goods ensure happiness. For others, joy is found in helping others. We should live in the present, thinking about the future, but also projecting everything beyond, towards the next phase of life, where we will be in the Father's house, face to face with God.

Unfortunately, today's lifestyle and social propaganda, point to material goods as a means of seeking happiness: money, travel, vacation, etc. But experience tells us that these things are temporary and superficial and cannot provide stable happiness.

Is it possible for us to attain permanent happiness? For this, Jesus situates us in a horizon of love and communion with the Father in heaven. For us, as for God, there can be no greater joy than the salvation of a person. He or she, who was dehumanizing and destroying himself or who, after a long process, succeeds in abandoning the wrong path and begins to live an authentic human life.

The parable of the prodigal son is a good example. Many parents and educators could tell us about the joy they felt when a child or a young man who was losing themselves then decides to abandon drugs, alcohol, or violence, to begin to work towards becoming a responsible human being.

The parable that we read in the gospel is extremely positive and hopeful; it tells us that God will have immense joy over one sinner who repents.

The path to happiness: First, a desire to return to the right path (CONVERSION); there you will find God's FORGIVENESS and the result is the HAPPINESS of being saved, finding oneself in communion with God in love for Him and others.

May we seek true happiness and not the false joy that led to disasters in the human person.

Queridas familias:

La conversión, el perdón y la alegría son tres aspectos relacionados entre sí en la vida del ser humano.

Somos limitados. No somos todopoderosos; nacemos necesitados de otros. Por eso tratamos siempre de buscar la independencia y asegurar la felicidad y la alegría. Pero no siempre la buscamos allí donde se encuentra. Para unos lo importante es disfrutar el presente, para otros asegurar el futuro. En ambos casos, se enfoca la vida de modo materialista pues se piensa que los bienes materiales aseguran la felicidad. Para otros la alegría se encuentra en ayudar a los demás. Hemos de vivir el presente, pensando en el futuro y proyectando todo hacia el más allá. Allí veremos a Dios cara a cara, estaremos en la casa del Padre.

Desgraciadamente, la propaganda y el estilo de vida de la sociedad de hoy apuntan a los bienes materiales como medio de buscar la alegría: dinero, viajes, vacaciones, etc. Pero la experiencia nos dice que estas cosas son pasajeras y superficiales y no pueden proporcionar una felicidad estable.

¿Será posible la alegría permanente? Jesús nos sitúa para ello en un horizonte de amor y de comunión con el Padre del cielo. Para nosotros, como para Dios, no puede haber alegría mayor que la salvación de una persona. Aquel o aquella que se estaba deshumanizando y destruyendo o que después de un largo proceso, logra abandonar el mal camino y se pone a vivir una vida auténticamente humana.

La parábola del hijo prodigo constituye un buen ejemplo. Son muchos los padres y los educadores que podrían hablarnos de la alegría cuando un hijo o un joven, que se estaba perdiendo, ha decidido abandonar la droga, el alcohol, o la violencia, para empezar a esforzarse y a trabajar para hacer de él o de ella un hombre o una mujer responsable.

La parábola que leemos en el evangelio es tremendamente positiva y esperanzadora; en ella nos dice que Dios tendrá una alegría inmensa por un solo pecador que se convierta.

Camino de la alegría: Primero desear volver al camino correcto (CONVERSION); allí se encuentra el PERDON de Dios y la consecuencia es la ALEGRIA de estar salvado, de encontrarse en comunión con Dios en el amor a El y a los demás.

Que busquemos la alegría verdadera, no las falsas alegrías que conducen a desastres en la persona humana.

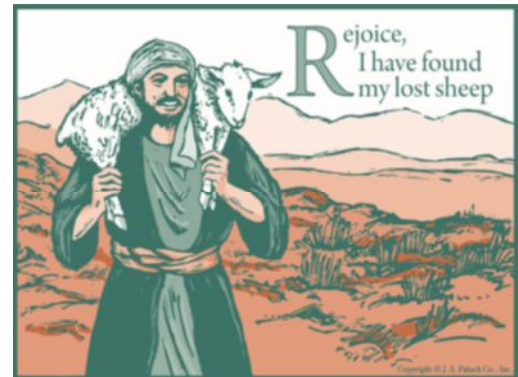
