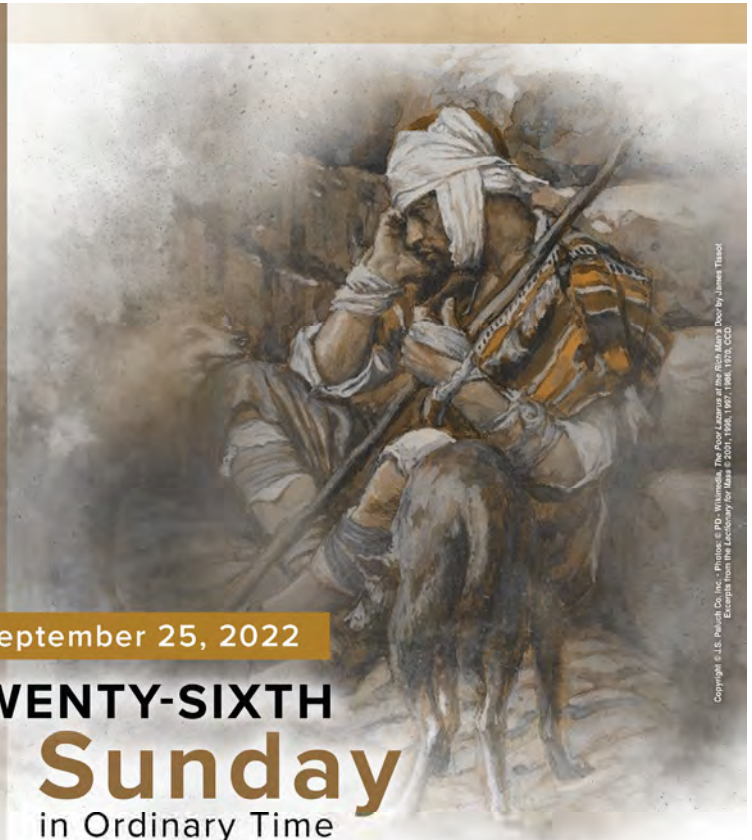

Amos 6:1^a, 4-7; 1 Timothy 6:11-16;

Luke 16:19-31; Psalm 146

Dear Families:

We read in today's Gospel the parable of the rich man and Lazarus, a poor man. Understanding the parable is very easy: he who lived as "rich" during his lifetime will have a poor life in the next life, and conversely, he who lived in poverty during his lifetime, will enjoy the wealth of the **Kingdom of God**.

It is not wealth itself which condemns man, but indifference toward the poor and ignoring the suffering and needs of those less fortunate. The rich man died in his wealth while Lazarus died abandoned. This certainly was not fair, and not what we want. We want to believe that we are better than this; that benefits are distributed equally.

Therefore, it is very important to read what Jesus placed in the mouth of Abraham in the afterlife; he tells the rich man:

"between us and you a great chasm is established to prevent anyone from crossing who might wish to go from our side to yours or from your side to ours."

True religion cannot exist without love for the poor and without the practice of charity towards the needy. We cannot remove the gaps completely, but we can decrease them while we help forge the **Kingdom of God** here on earth. Experience tells us that providing help and charity to that person we encounter every day, makes them grow in hope and "well-being;" and in us, a culture of charity and love. Faced with a culture of money, power, riches, we have to oppose it with a culture of fraternity, charity, solidarity, and love. Faced with a culture of indifference, we must act with care and concern for the dispossessed.

As Christians, we have to be consistent in what St. Paul tells us in today's second reading taken from the Letter to Timothy: **"Pursue righteousness, devotion, faith, love, patience, and gentleness. Compete well for the faith, Lay hold of eternal life, to which you were called."** These words sum up what should be a life lived from God and oriented towards God.

Vigésimo-Sexto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

25 de septiembre del 2022

Amós 6: 1^a, 4-7; 1 Timoteo 6:11-16;

Lucas 16:19-31; Salmo 146

Queridas familias:

Leemos en el evangelio de hoy la parábola del rico Epulón y del pobre Lázaro. Entender la parábola es muy fácil: el que en esta vida vivió como "rico" tendrá una vida pobre en el más allá; y a la inversa: el que vivió aquí como pobre gozará de la riqueza del **Reino de Dios**.

No es la riqueza en sí misma la que condena al hombre, sino el uso de esta, la cerrazón hacia el pobre y la indiferencia hacia los sufrimientos y necesidades de los que menos tienen. El rico murió en su riqueza y Lázaro murió abandonado; y esto no es justo y no es lo que deseamos. Yo quiero creer que todos deseamos vivir mejor y que todos vivan mejor. Que no haya esos abismos, esas diferencias.

Por eso es tan importante leer lo que pone Jesús en boca de Abrahám en la otra vida; le dice al rico Epulón: **"entre ustedes y nosotros se abre un abismo inmenso, que nadie puede cruzar, ni hacía allá ni hacía acá."**

La auténtica religión no puede existir sin amor a los pobres y sin el ejercicio de la caridad con los necesitados. No quitaremos los abismos, pero haremos que sean menos y así cooperaremos a que el **Reino de Dios** comience a fraguarse aquí en la tierra. La experiencia nos dice que la ayuda, la caridad con aquella persona que nos encontramos cada día, hace que crezca en ella la esperanza y la "salud" y en nosotros la cultura de la caridad y el amor. Frente a la cultura del dinero, del poder, de las riquezas tenemos que oponer la cultura de la fraternidad, caridad, solidaridad, amor. Frente a la cultura de la indiferencia hemos de actuar con atención y solicitud por los más desposeídos.

Los cristianos hemos de ser constantes en lo que nos dice San Pablo en la segunda lectura de hoy tomada de la carta a Timoteo: **"Practica la justicia, la religión, la fe, el amor, la paciencia, la delicadeza" – "conquista la vida eterna a la que fuiste llamado"**. Estas palabras resumen lo que debe ser una vida vivida desde Dios y orientada hacia Dios.

I am lactose intolerant so I cannot drink milk. Problem is, in prison, cereal is a major part of the breakfasts served every day. And cereal needs milk; I'd go hungry if I couldn't eat the cereal. The dietician prescribed soy milk. Years ago, soy milk was disgusting! It had an unpleasant vitamin/medicinal taste. However, as I read the nutrition facts on the back of the soy milk carton, I noticed that it was packed with vitamins and minerals (as my taste buds affirmed). It was the most nutritious part of my diet, and gave me pleasure to know I was ingesting something so plainly healthy for me. Overtime, that pleasure even overpowered the bad taste: I came to enjoy soy milk because of what I knew about it.

Similarly, many trials I face are quite unpleasant. Yet, over the years, I've come to see how God

uses them to build my character - just as His word assures me. And knowing God uses my trials to make me more Christ-like (i.e. godly) gives me a deep spiritual joy that challenges the physical discomfort of the trial. I hope that one day the joy totally overpowers it; I'm not there yet, but I see my joy increasing with each overcome obstacle.

Finally, I understand how we can "consider it pure joy" when we face trials of many kinds: By knowing they are spiritually nutritious for us. Amen.



Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

El fin de semana del 1 al 2 de Octubre de este año será el Domingo Mundial de las Misiones. Nos unimos a los católicos de todo el mundo en esta celebración Eucarística anual por las Misiones de la Iglesia.

El Papa Francisco reflexiona sobre el tema de este año: "Serán mis testigos" (Hechos 1:8). Enfatiza el llamado a todo cristiano a dar testimonio de Cristo, a participar en una misión de evangelización universal, y a buscar la fuerza y la guía del Espíritu Santo.

A partir de 1822, el fondo universal de la Sociedad para la Propagación de la Fe proporcionó unos \$7 millones en ayuda a las Iglesias nuevas y en crecimiento en los Estados Unidos. Sus oraciones y apoyo generoso sostienen hoy a los sacerdotes, religiosos y líderes pastorales laicos en más de 1100 diócesis misioneras en Asia, África, las Islas del Pacífico y partes de América Latina y Europa mientras proclaman el Evangelio, construyen la Iglesia y sirven a los pobres.

La Beata Paulina Jaricot comenzó este trabajo hace 200 años. Como nos recuerda el Papa Francisco, "Ella aceptó la inspiración de Dios para establecer una red de oración y colecta para misioneros para que los fieles pudieran participar activamente en la misión 'hasta los confines de la tierra'". Su visión conduciría al Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, que ayuda al Papa a sostener la actividad misionera.
