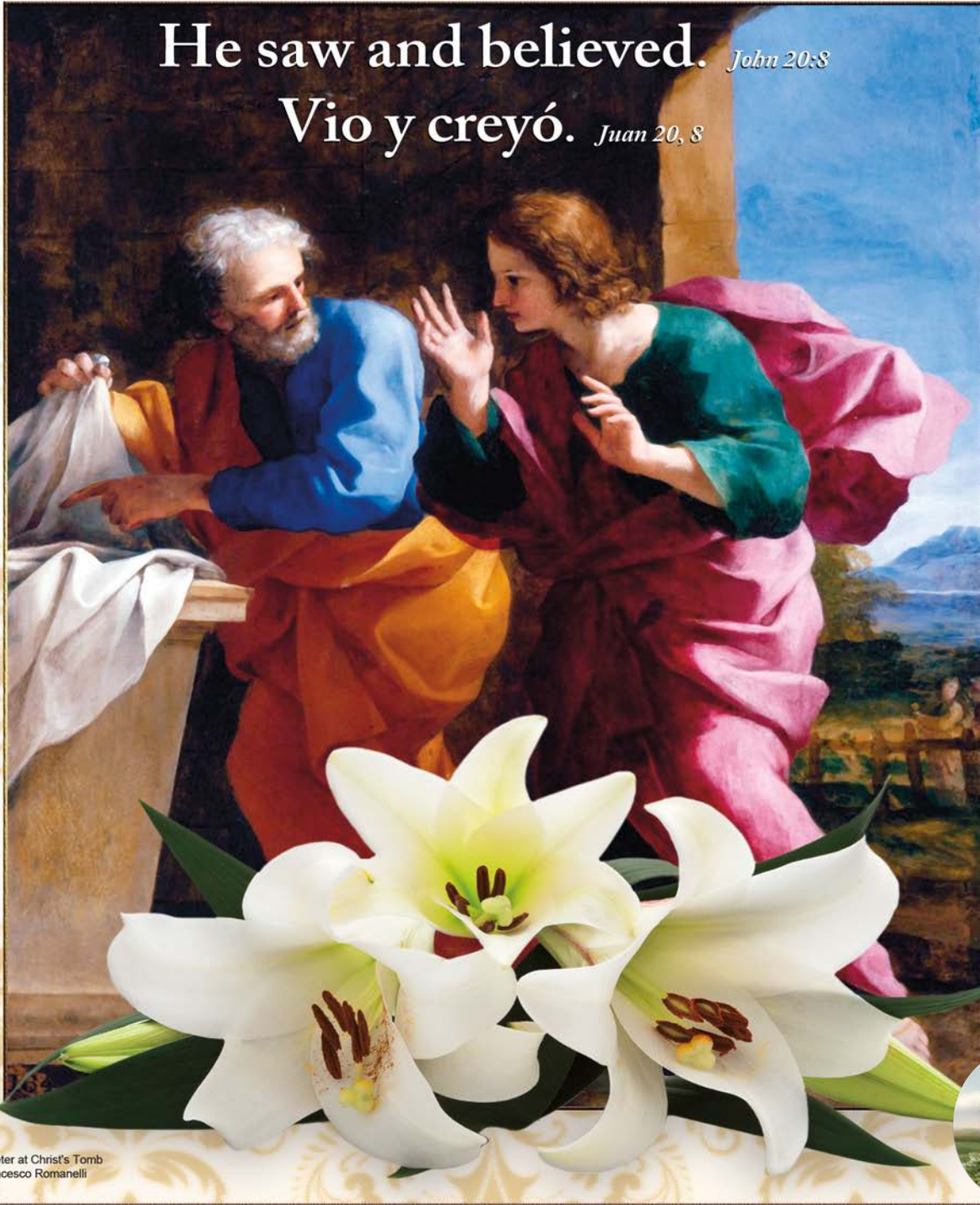

**HAPPY EASTER** brothers and sisters. Jesus Christ is risen!! He is no longer in the tomb. Life has triumphed forever. It is with great joy today that we celebrate the victory of our God. Our Lord, by allowing His Son Jesus to enter the tomb, has changed history. He has given us the great gift of Easter. Death no longer rules, and life is the one that triumphs. That is why the believers live by the One who has given us life and taught us to respect every form of life. When we see Jesus on the cross, we no longer think only of his death, but also of the life that comes out of it. We do not think so much of his entry into the tomb as of his triumph on the cross.

When Mary Magdalene makes the great discovery of the empty tomb, she experiences the greatest joy of the human being. To discover that living with the Risen One is the gift that God has given us; to live forever, like Jesus, and with Him.

The joy of this day is the joy that fills the heart of every believer who finds Jesus, and with Him, the fullness of life. Easter joy is what we experience every day when we gather in community to celebrate the Eucharist, which is the very presence of the one who lives forever among us and within us. The risen Jesus became the Eucharist; he became the "encountered"; he became the companion on the journey par excellence. For this reason, we no longer feel alone, because he walks by our side, but also because he brings us together as a family. May Jesus' Passover help us to live our Passover, and each day, our earthly life.

# DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY


the first Sunday after Easter

**THE HISTORY**  
Jesus began appearing to St. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, in 1931. The message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy is based on her published diary recording the revelations she received from Jesus. St. Faustina died in 1938, at 33 years old, and was canonized by St. John Paul II in 2000.

**THE PROMISE**  
Our Lord Jesus said, "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates throughout which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet... Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy."  
— Saint Faustina, Diary, 699

**WHY IS THIS PROMISE FROM JESUS SO WONDERFUL AND MERCIFUL?**  
**TEMPORAL PUNISHMENT AND SUFFERING:**  
The Catholic Church teaches that sin has two consequences, or punishments. (CCC 1472). The first is eternal punishment in which the soul loses heaven and is confined to an eternity in Hell. This punishment is remitted through the forgiveness of sins. The second is temporal punishment, in which a person must expiate, or make reparation for his sins. This temporal punishment remains even after sin is forgiven. This temporal punishment is known as Purgatory.  
So, Jesus's amazing promise to St. Faustina amounts to offering all mankind the graces of a COMPLETE PARDON; an opportunity to have all temporal punishment, time in Purgatory, that which would be necessary before entrance into Heaven, completely removed!

**TO OBSERVE DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY**  
Sincerely repent of all of your sins. Place your complete trust in Jesus. Go to Confession, the Church permits up to 20 days before the Feast. Receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday. Venerate the image, such as a prayer before it, "Merciful Jesus, I trust in You!" Be merciful to others, through our actions, words, and prayers.



**THE IMAGE**  
"I desire that this image be venerated throughout the world. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I promise victory over its enemies, already here on earth, and especially at the hour of death... I Myself will defend it as My own glory."

**THE CHAPLET**  
"Pray unceasingly the Chaplet that I have taught you. Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death. Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation."

**THE CONVERSION PRAYER**  
"If you say this prayer, with a contrite heart and with faith, on behalf of some sinner, I will give that soul the grace of conversion:  
*'O Blood and Water that gushed forth from the heart of Jesus, as a fount of mercy for us. I trust in You.'*  
— Diary 186, 187




**Eucharist Minister Request for Help**

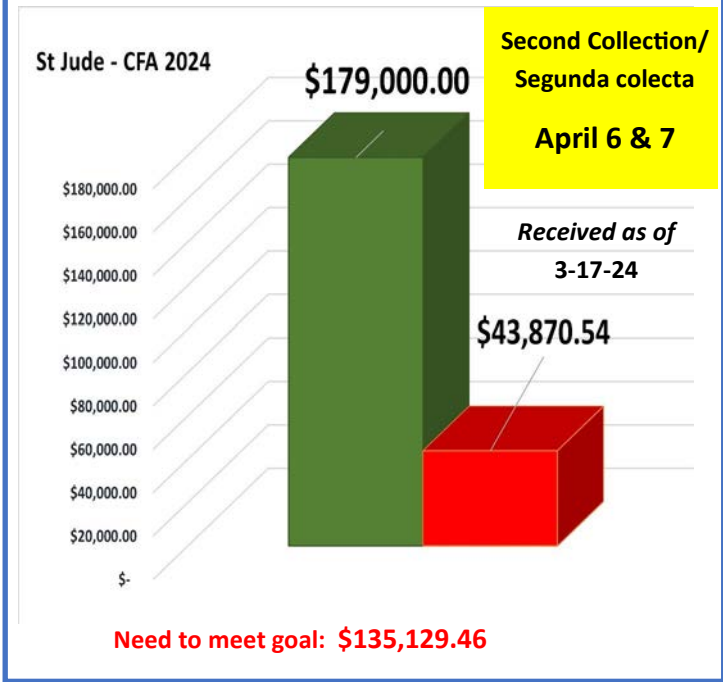

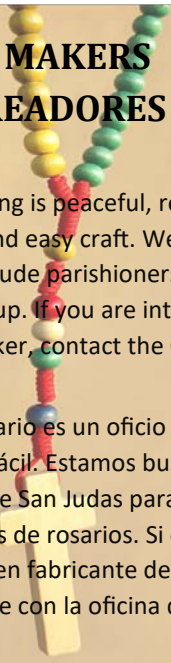
