

## Message from our Pastor, Fr. Jobani Batista

A very blessed Sunday, brothers and sisters.

Water is life—we hear it often, and it is true. The Word of God uses water as a symbol rich in meaning. One of its deepest meanings is to show us our need to turn to God, the source and well that offers water capable of quenching our thirst forever.

The prophet Jeremiah reminds us that when we turn away from God, we are left without water; we “dig cracked cisterns that cannot hold the water that gives life” (Jer 2:13). Jesus also presents Himself as the source of living water: seeking Him and remaining close to Him is to find the fullness our hearts long for.

Like the Samaritan woman, let us ask Jesus to quench our thirst for Him; to be, in our lives, the inexhaustible source and the well of living water that gives meaning to our existence. And let us say with the psalmist: “As the deer longs for streams of water, so my soul longs for you, my God” (Ps 42).

Dios les bendiga.


Um ótimo domingo, irmãos e irmãs.
